CALL FOR PAPERS

Maritime security is indivisible and interdependent. Currently, no state is immune from the effects of a maritime related incidents. However, the geographical and legal status have shaped and simplified the acquiring the maritime security of the Black Sea.

Despite the fact that roughly 50.000 ships have been navigating through Turkish Straits either to or from the Black Sea, quarter of which have been petroleum tankers, and they have carried almost half a billion tons of goods, and there have been no major incident in the Black Sea.

These contradictions precise that the Montreux Convention is not just an international treaty that governs the passage of ships through the Turkish Straits, it also carries much more legal significance for the security of the Black Sea maritime domain and therefore the importance of the Montreux regime can neither be overstated nor ignored. Possessing Turkish Straits and the longest coastline in the Black Sea, Turkey has always promoted peace and stability in this important area.

At this point, Multinational Maritime Security Centre of Excellence (MARSEC COE) has always been a centre for strategic studies as well as a multinational hub for practical training in the field of Maritime Security. Therefore, MARSEC COE is committed to the maritime security related issues of the international community.

Building upon our already extensive involvement of these activities and our ambition, it was decided to carry this regional endeavor to the next level. We will organize our first International Maritime Security Symposium which is "INTERNATIONAL BLACKSEA MARSEC SYMPOSIUM-2019".

This annual Symposium will not only provide the intellectual power and context for future maritime security events, but also will bring together key individuals, leaders and decision makers from international, regional and national maritime

security organizations, government/military officials, representatives from shipping and industry.

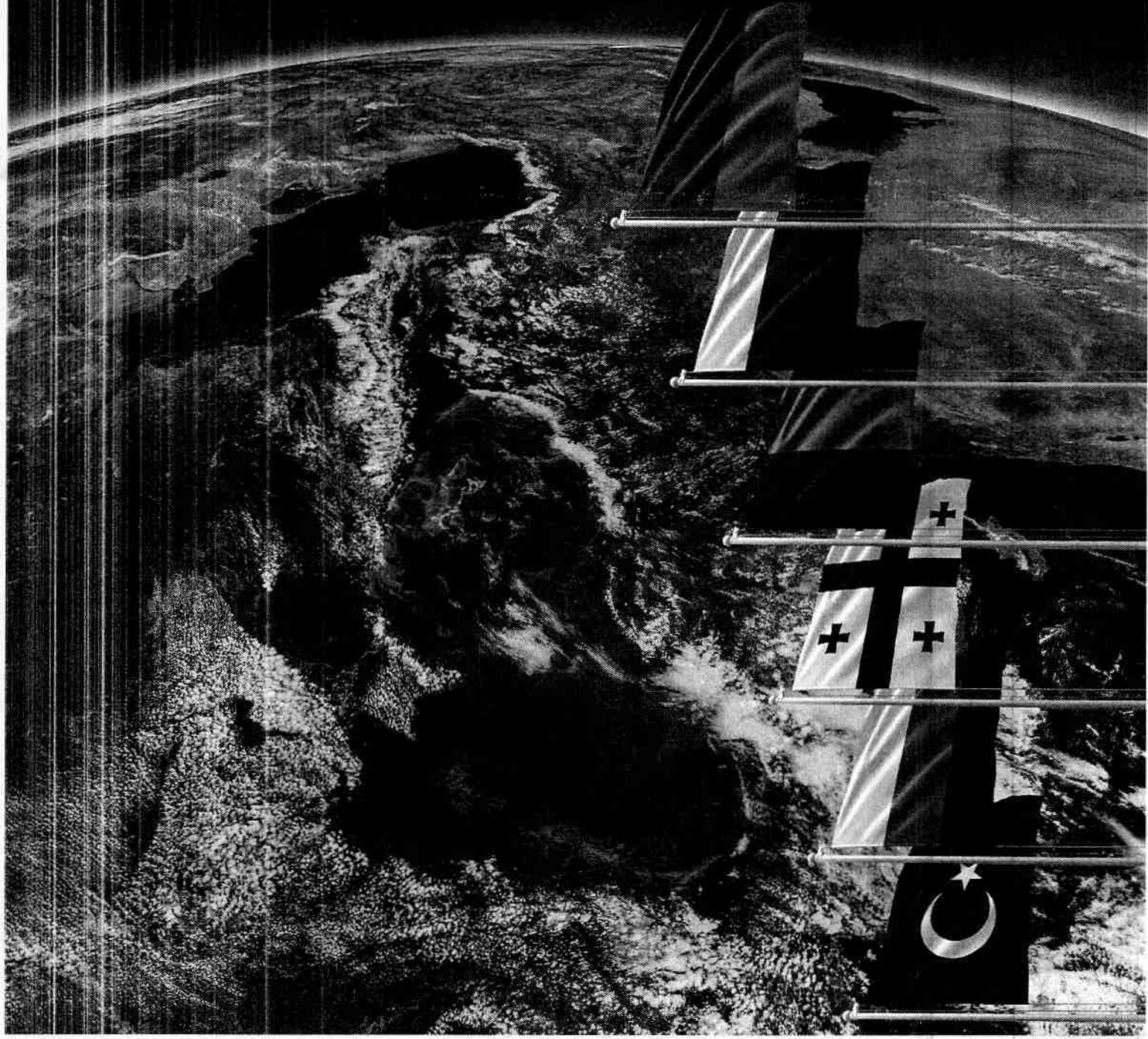

1. Conference Location and the Weather:

a. Location: International Black Sea Maritime Security Symposium-2019 (BLACKSEA MARSEC SYMP-19) will be held at Naval Museum located in Beşiktaş/Istanbul. The below link takes you to the Naval Museum location:

b. Weather: The average temperature in İstanbul in June is hot at 26 °C.

2. Schedule:

The agenda is in Annex-2 to the invitation letter. Some take aways:

a. The Symposium is 2 days long (27th-28th of June 2019) including cultural programme.

b. There will be one lunch (buffet) in Naval Museum and a lunch box that will be provided during Istanbul Strait Boat Tour. Small refreshments will be served during coffee breaks.

3. Transportation:
