ISPS CODE COURSE DESCRIPTION FORM

1.	AIM	The aim of this course is to provide current and future Ship Security Officers (SSO), shipboard personnel, the Company Security Officers (CSO), Port Facility Security Officers (PFSSO) and appropriate personnel (law enforcement and government/military entities) with knowledge and ability to perform their assigned duties described in the context of International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code. This Course meets the requirements of the ISPS Code and the requirements specified in IMO Model courses 3.19, 3.20, 3.21.
2.	TYPE OF APPLICATION	This one week course will enable relevant personnel to perform their assigned duties described in the context of International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) Code. The course will be held at Maritime Security Centre of Excellence (MARSEC COE) with Instructor-LED training.
3.	DURATION	3 days
4.	COURSE DATES	19-21 March 2019
5.	VENUE	Multinational Maritime Security Centre of Excellence (MARSEC COE) National Defence University Campus/Yenilevent-Besiktas/ISTANBUL https://www.google.com/maps/place/Nispetiye+Kadikoy+Warfare+Center
6.	CAPACITY	Up to 30 participants. Allocations will be on a "first come-first served" basis.
7.	PERSONAL QUALIFICATIONS	1. Personnel responsible for or involved with maritime security onboard ships and at port facilities and appropriate personnel (law enforcement and government/military entities) who have been allocated potential or specific tasks in an existing security programme. 2. Navy/CG personnel (LT.-CAPT), appropriate personnel (SSO, CSO, PFSSO) from government agencies (intelligence and maritime administration), fixed and floating platforms and mobile offshore drilling units' security personnel and other maritime security stakeholders (Chamber of Shipping, Recognized Security Organizations (RSOs)) who are likely to engage in ISPS Code related issues. 3. English language proficiency as described in STANAG 6001-3332 (Listening (good/3), speaking (good/3), reading (good/3) and writing (fair/2)). 1. Define national, regional and global maritime security initiatives, current security threats and patterns. 2. Define the nature of ship/facility and how they are affected by the requirements of the ISPS code. 3. Develop and use risk assessment tools for the ships, port facilities, fixed and floating platforms and mobile offshore drilling units. 4. Distinguish the mandatory and guidance regulations of the ISPS code 5. Prepare the 3 levels of the Ship Security Plan (SSP) and Port Facility Security Plan (PFSP) with enhanced knowledge of security issues. 6. Operate security assets in accordance with the port facility security plan. 7. Control required training, drills and exercises.
8.	LEARNING OBJECTIVES	1. Understand the facts and transnational challenges in maritime domain. 2. Recognize security precaution tools and equipment which are described in the ship and harbor security plan. 3. Calculate risk assessment for the ships, port facilities, fixed and floating platforms and mobile offshore drilling units by risk assessment tools. 4. Explain the difference between the mandatory and guidance regulations of the ISPS code. 5. Produce 3 levels of the Ship Security Plan (SSP) and Port Facility Security Plan (PFSP) in accordance with the given case study (generic ship/facility) scenario. 6. Effectively operate security assets in accordance with the port facility security plan with the ships security officer and ships master. 7. Examine required training, drills and exercises to ensure familiarity with security plans and procedures.
9.	THE SUBTITLES OF COURSE PROGRAMME	No Need.
10.	SECURITY CLEARANCE	No Need.

11.	FINANCIAL ISSUES	1. Course fee is 1000 USD. Course will be free of charge within the frame of bilateral agreements with some NATO, NATO Partners and other UN countries. Course fee will be paid in cash and includes educational expenditures. 2. Administrative fee is 10 USD. Administrative fee will be paid in cash and includes: a. Group photo, b. Drinks/cookies during breaks, c. Course CD. 3. Financial matters (accommodation, meals and tickets) are to be paid by the participants.
12.	ACCOMMODATION	1. There are 2 options for accommodation: Hotels and limited military facilities. 2. Military facilities will be used on a "first come-first served" bases if requested. 3. Please specify your choice of accommodation in personnel attendance form. 4. Prices for single room at central Istanbul hotels should be checked on internet. Hotel reservations should be made by the participants.
13.	DRESS	Daily or working uniform.
14.	VISA ARRANGEMENTS	1. Participants are required to have passport or "NATO Travel Order" together with ID Card to satisfy border control measures. 2. Participants or their sending authorities are responsible for their own visa arrangements. Turkish Authorities do not require a letter of invitation. Visa can be obtained upon arrival to Istanbul/Ataturk/Sabiha Gokcen Airport. However, if in doubt it is advised that participants contact their national embassies/consulates in Turkey or the Turkish Military Attachés at the Turkish Embassies/Consulates in their capitals.
15.	LEGAL PROCEDURES	The participants from those countries which are not parties to NATO/SOFA and/or PIP/SOFA or which do not have any Bilateral Military Training and Cooperation Agreement with the Republic of Turkey shall be treated in accordance with Turkish Domestic Legislation during their stay in Turkey.
16.	MEDICAL	All participants are advised to have medical insurance.
17.	TRANSPORTATION	1. Nearest airports are Istanbul/Ataturk/Sabiha Gokcen Airport/Istanbul/TURKEY. 2. Detailed information: Airport web sites.
18.	REMARKS	1. The course is open to NATO, NATO Partners and other UN Countries. 2. All applications should be sent no later than 4 March 2019. 3. Participants are requested to fax or e-mail the personnel attendance form after receiving confirmation e-mail from us.
